THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH PUTNAM COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT ISSUES MOSQUITO- BORNE ILLNESSES ADVISORY

PUTNAM COUNTY--This is to advise that there has been increased mosquito-borne disease activity in areas of Putnam County.

Several of our sentinel chicken flocks/mosquito pools have tested positive for West Nile virus infection. **The risk of transmission to humans has been increased.**

Putnam County Health Department reminds residents and visitors to avoid being bitten by mosquitoes that may cause encephalitis disease. Putnam County Mosquito Control and the health department continue surveillance and prevention efforts and encourage everyone to take basic precautions to help limit exposure by following the department of health recommendations. To protect yourself from mosquitoes, you should remember to:

"Drain and Cover"

DRAIN standing water to stop mosquitoes from multiplying

COVER skin with clothing or repellent

COVER doors and windows with screens to keep mosquitoes out of your house.

CALLING ALL ARTISTS, MUSICIANS AND ACTORS!

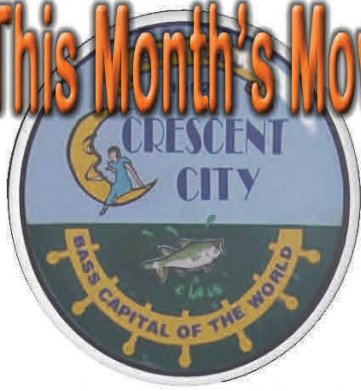
