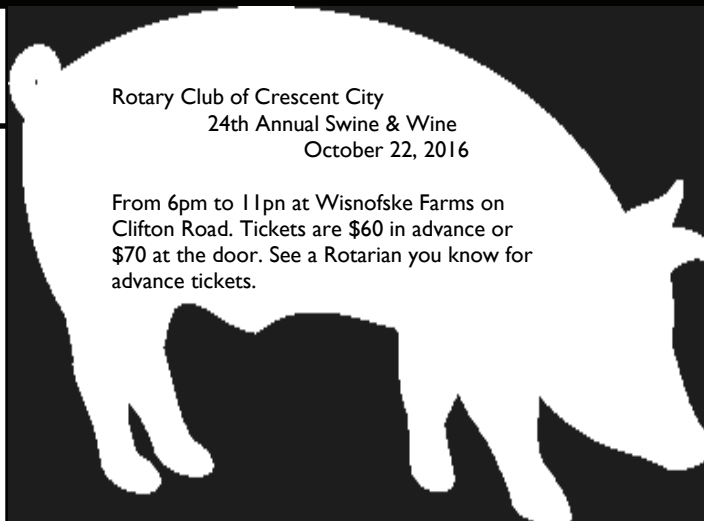

A Year Full of Projects Ahead!!

In case you missed it with the budget amendments proposed for the agenda in October, Crescent City has a lot of projects scheduled the coming year:

- Gas Line Relocation Phase II - \$1.5 Million
- Stormwater Outfall Repair and Improvement on Crescent Lake - \$550,000
- Paving Walnut Street - \$435,000
- Eva Lyon Park Improvements - \$178,000
- Harry Banks Community Park Improvements - \$50,000
- Police Vehicle Purchase (2) - \$65,000

Total capital projects budget for FY2017 is roughly \$2,769,000 and of which approximately \$2,618,000 is grant funded.

We also expect the Fish & Wildlife Conservation Commission to come through with the grant we were awarded for the final phase of Margary Neal Nelson Sunrise Park, which totals \$375,000 and will clean up the shoreline and install a 170ft fishing and boating pier
