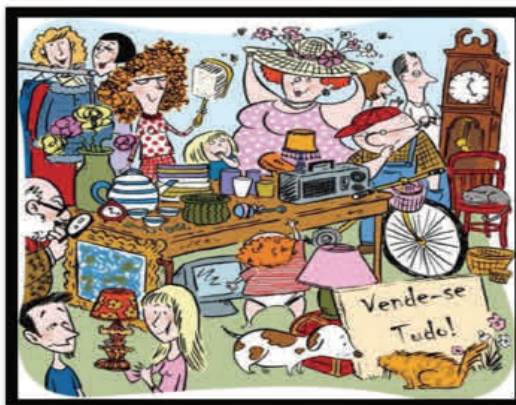
The City Commission Agenda is still being developed at this time and will be sent out in a supplemental email. Thank you for your patience.

DISASTER RECOVERY ASSISTANCE

If you have received damage and need assistance due to Hurricane Irma and have yet to register with FEMA, you have several options. You can apply for Individual Assistance (IA) online or you can call. See flyer on page 2. Or you can apply in person at the Disaster Assistance Recovery Center.

Putnam County –FEMA Disaster Recovery Center (DRC)

You can also go to the Resource Center at the Putnam County Fairgrounds over the next two weeks. The address is 118 Fairgrounds Rd. East Palatka from 8am – 8pm from 9/26/17 through 10/09/17. Staff from FEMA will be there to answer questions and review cases if you have questions. You should bring you Social Security Number, Insurance Information, Damage Information, Financial Information, Contact Information, and Direct Deposit Information. For citizens needing transportation to the center, you can call Ride Solutions to schedule transportation.

REMOVING YOUR OWN DEBRIS?

For citizens wishing to haul their own vegetative storm debris without tipping fees, a drop-off site is open. The schedule is Monday through Saturday from 8:30am until 5pm. The location is at the Fairgrounds overflow parking at 118 Fairgrounds Rd. East Palatka. Residents using this site will need to show proof of residency for Putnam county. An ID, utility bill or tax bill linking their name to the property is sufficient. No commercial vehicles or other types of debris

will be accepted at this site. Residents and commercial vehicles can take vegetation and other types of debris to the Central Landfill, Interlachen convenient center or the Huntington convenient center. Tipping fees may apply depending on size and type of debris. Please contact the sanitation department at 386-329-0395 if you have questions. **(NO BAGGED DEBRIS CAN BE TAKEN TO THIS SITE)**
