CRESCENT CITY LIBRARY To Host Family Literacy Program

The Putnam County Library System has received a grant from the Florida Humanities Council to host a family literacy program at the Crescent City Public Library Thursdays at 6pm from February 16 through March 23. “The program, PRIME TIME FAMILY READING TIME®, targets children aged 6 to 10 who may be experiencing difficulty with reading and their parents in an effort to foster a lifelong love of learning through reading,” says Stella Brown, Reference Administrator for the Library System. Families can start registering now at the Crescent City Public Library.

PRIME TIME, a six week series of reading and discussion programs, includes sessions on such themes as fairness, greed, courage, cleverness, and determination and is designed to get parents and children reading together. These weekly programs include a nutritious snack as well as child care services for younger siblings (ages 0-5). A discussion leader and a storyteller introduce parents to the benefits and pleasures of reading and discussing stories with their children. The program aims to expand participants’ understanding of reading through the use of children’s literature with substantial humanities content.

“PRIME TIME introduces families to the pleasures and benefits of reading together and the many resources and services of the public library,” says Patricia Putman, Associate Director of PRIME TIME programs here in Florida. “We’re pleased to be working with the Putnam County Library System to bring this exciting family literacy program to the citizens of Crescent City.” The Florida Humanities Council is a private, statewide, non-profit affiliate of the National Endowment for the Humanities.
